ARC – in coordination with GDOT and other regional partners – coordinates regional TDM planning for the Atlanta region. ARC administers programs to reduce and eliminate trips through a variety of strategies. ARC staff will provide an overview of these efforts with the goal to inform regional policymakers of these strategies.

Understanding regional commute patterns is a foundation of ARC's transportation planning efforts. The ARC Mobility Services team conducts surveys every 3-5 years through the regional Transportation Demand Management (TDM) program, currently Georgia Commute Options (GCO). Staff will provide highlights of the latest survey in order to inform policy makers on current commute flows.
