A. Green Communities

Crystal Jackson, Planning Manager, Climate + Sustainability, Natural Resources

The Green Communities Program is a voluntary certification program for jurisdictions in the 11-county Atlanta Region to encourage local governments to become more environmentally sustainable. This presentation provides a brief overview of the program and recognizes the seven communities who received recertification in 2023.

ARC is taking a regional approach to climate action. This presentation will discuss:

- Two major trends influencing the region: increasing extreme weather events and changing conditions, and energy transformation
- Significant investment of federal funding exists now to address these trends

D. Aging: Live Beyond Expectations Update

The ARC Board approved the 2020-2025 Live Beyond Expectations Strategic Framework, which focuses on disparities in life expectancy within our region, in 2020. Since then, the Aging & Independence Services Department has been taking a deep dive into better understanding 10 census tracts in our region with low life expectancy.

- inform Board members how they can access more detailed county-level data; and
- invite Board members to be involved in next steps of identifying solutions and leveraging resources for these communities.
