## 2. <u>ACTION ITEM</u> – Issue Summary and DRAFT Resolution for TIP Amendment #4

This TIP Amendment will incorporate staff recommendations from the 2017 project solicitation and reflect other cost updates from the MMIP and miscellaneous other programming changes. A follow-up TIP Amendment #5 (May/June 2018) will incorporate other TIP solicitation recommendations that require conformity modeling. ARC staff will highlight major recommendations and seek feedback from policymakers.

# 3. <u>ACTION ITEM</u> – Issue Summary and DRAFT Resolution Adopting USDOT-Required Safety Targets

All states and MPOs are now required to set targets for safety, along with several other performance measures. The state of Georgia adopted safety targets in August and ARC is required to adopt MPO targets within 6 months. At prior TCC and TAQC meetings, the consensus was to pursue supporting state targets vs. ARC establishing alternative targets. This is a first read of the resolution, with TCC and TAQC scheduled to act on these targets in February.
