Transportation Coordinating Committee – Meeting Summary

1. Welcome, Acceptance of 01/08/2018 TCC Meeting Summary, Public Comment

John Orr, ARC, asked if there were any member comments on the draft 01/08/2017 TCC Meeting Summary. Hearing none, the summary was accepted as presented.

Mr. Orr asked for public comments. There were none.

2. ACTION ITEM – Issue Summary and DRAFT Resolution for TIP Amendment #4

Mr. Orr provided an update on the public comments received by ARC during the comment period. Comments were received in opposition to the proposed Douglas County transit, however, the project will remain a part of the TIP recommendations. The comments centered around the need for transit and public input opportunities.

Mr. Orr gave a general explanation of the project evaluation procedures for determining project selection and recommendation into the TIP, reiterating that the scheduling for TIP Amendment #5 us for projects subject to air quality conformity. Mr. Orr entertained a question regarding the schedule for administrative TIP modifications and amendments.

A motion to accept the TIP Amendment #4 resolution was made by Brian Allen of Rockdale County and seconded by Roussan Francois of Fulton County. The motion passed.

3. ACTION ITEM – Issue Summary and DRAFT Resolution Adopting USDOT-Required Safety Targets

Mr. Orr introduced the resolution to adopt USDOT required safety targets.

David Haynes, ARC, highlighted a minor change to the resolution. Mr. Haynes also responded to a question from the audience regarding consequences on not meeting targets.

A motion to accept the resolution on adopting USDOT required safety targets was made by Keith Rohling of Clayton County. The motion was seconded by Brian Allen of Rockdale County. The motion passed.
