2. Performance Targets Discussion

All states and MPOs are now required to set targets for highway performance measures. In late 2017, ARC agreed to support statewide targets set by GDOT for safety. In May 2018, GDOT approved additional targets for road and bridge conditions, congestion, reliability and air quality emissions. ARC is required to support those statewide targets or adopt separate targets for the MPO area within 6 months. ARC will provide an overview of the overall performance based planning process and federal requirements, while GDOT will discuss the recently released targets and, the data and methodology used in their development.

3. I-20 East Transit Oriented Design Strategic Blueprint Plan (*tentative*)

The Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority (MARTA) and DeKalb County are partnering to conduct the I-20 East Transit Oriented Development (TOD) Strategic Plan. The TOD Strategic Plan is funded by a grant from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) that includes contributions from MARTA and DeKalb County. The purpose of the project is to create a blueprint for Transit Oriented Development (TOD) at proposed transit station sites along the I-20 East corridor from Indian Creek Station to the Mall at Stonecrest. Staff will update TCC on the progress of the study.
