As part of the HB 930 legislation establishing the ATL Authority, state law has shifted the FTA designated recipient authority responsibilities for the Atlanta Urbanized Area from MARTA to the ATL. A first read on the resolution occurred in July. The State will formally request this change with FTA in September 2018, making it effective October 1, 2018.

- 5. Final Performance Measures Targets Next Steps and Actions

  GDOT has completed the final set of federally required performance targets, including categories such as system maintenance, congestion and air quality. TCC was previously briefed by GDOT and ARC staff in June. The MPO is required to adopt targets in November. Discussion on the targets and next steps will occur and a first read of a resolution to approve targets is expected in September.
