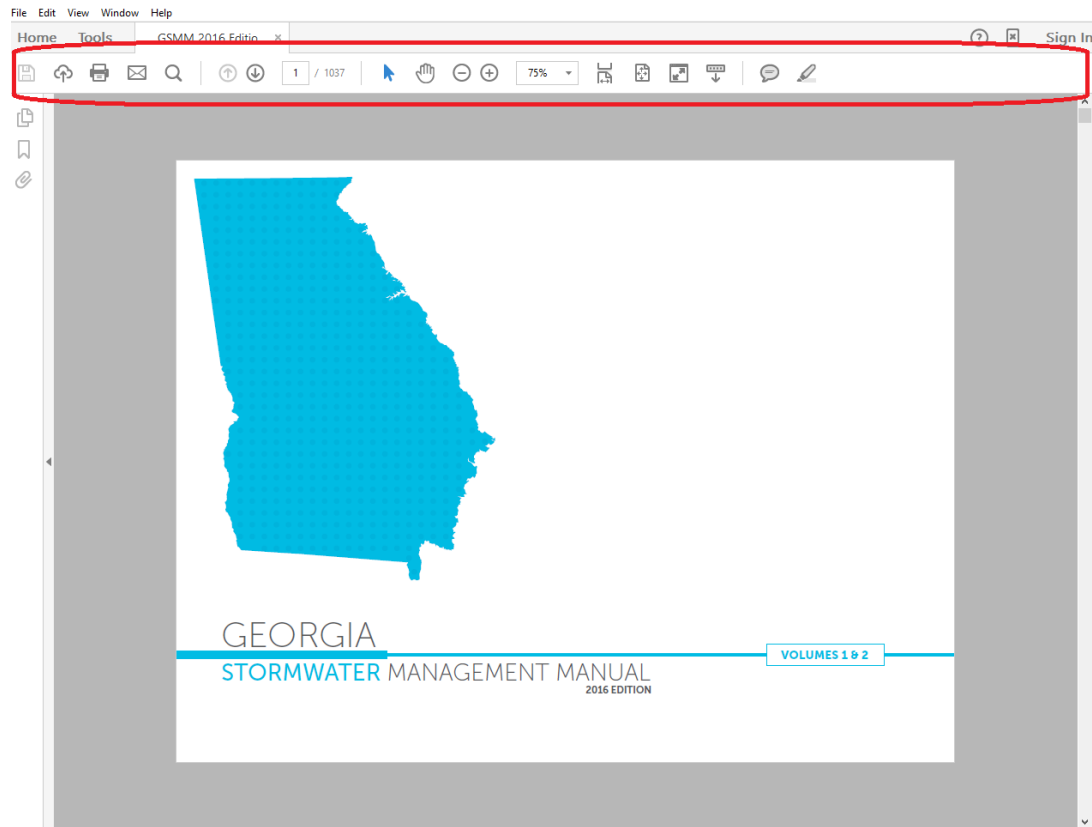


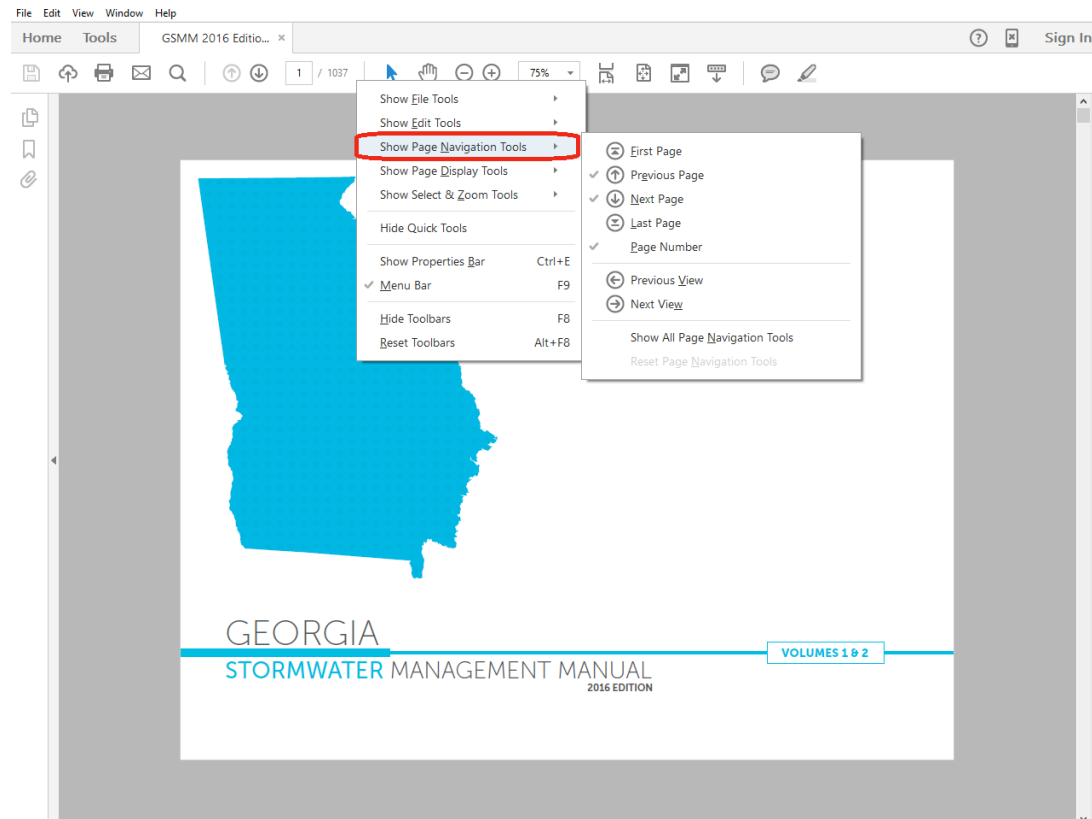
Configuring Adobe Acrobat Reader for Easier Navigation

Adobe Acrobat Reader can be set up to easily navigate back and forth when using the GSMM 2016 Edition's embedded links. Just follow these few steps.

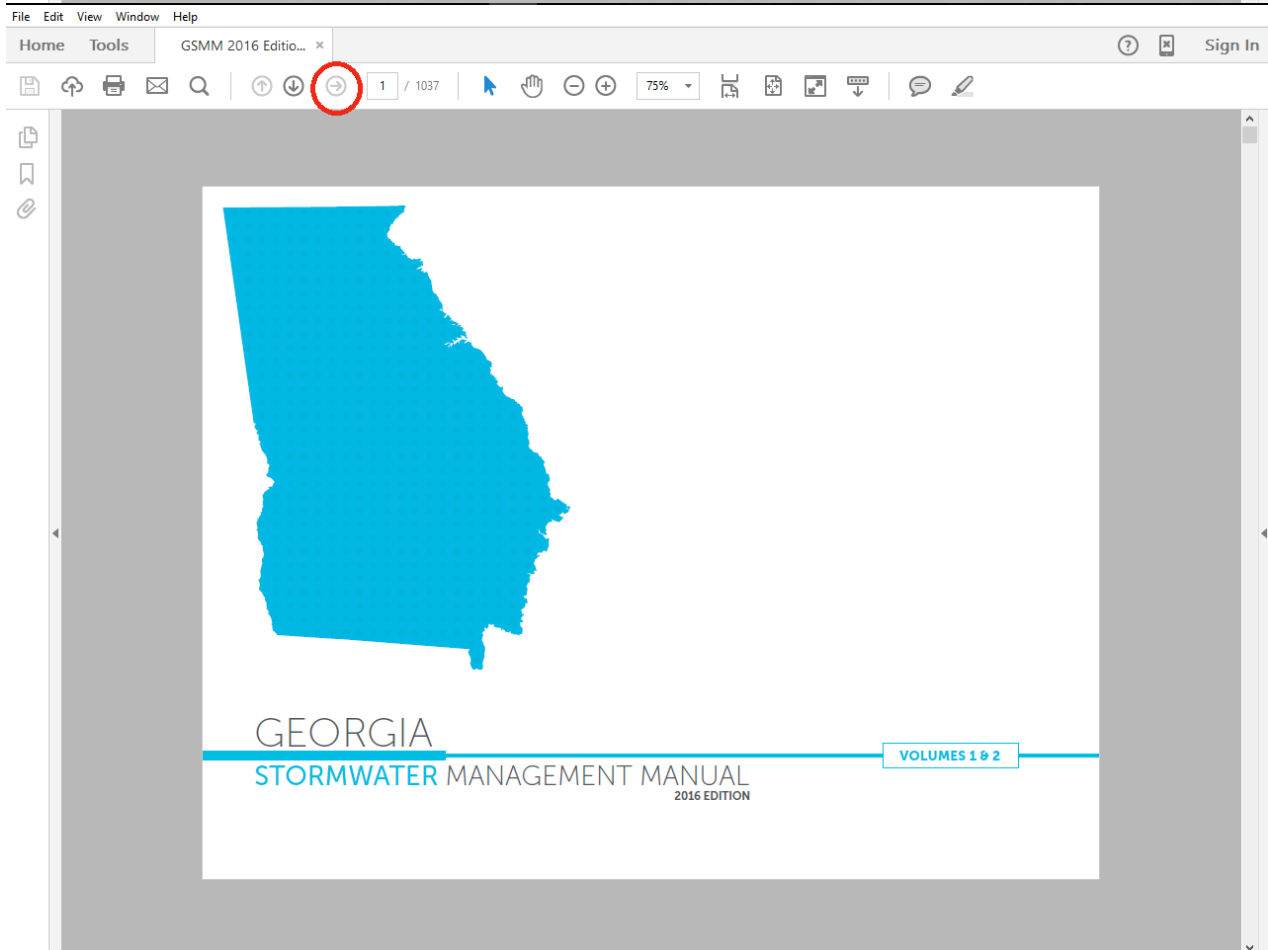
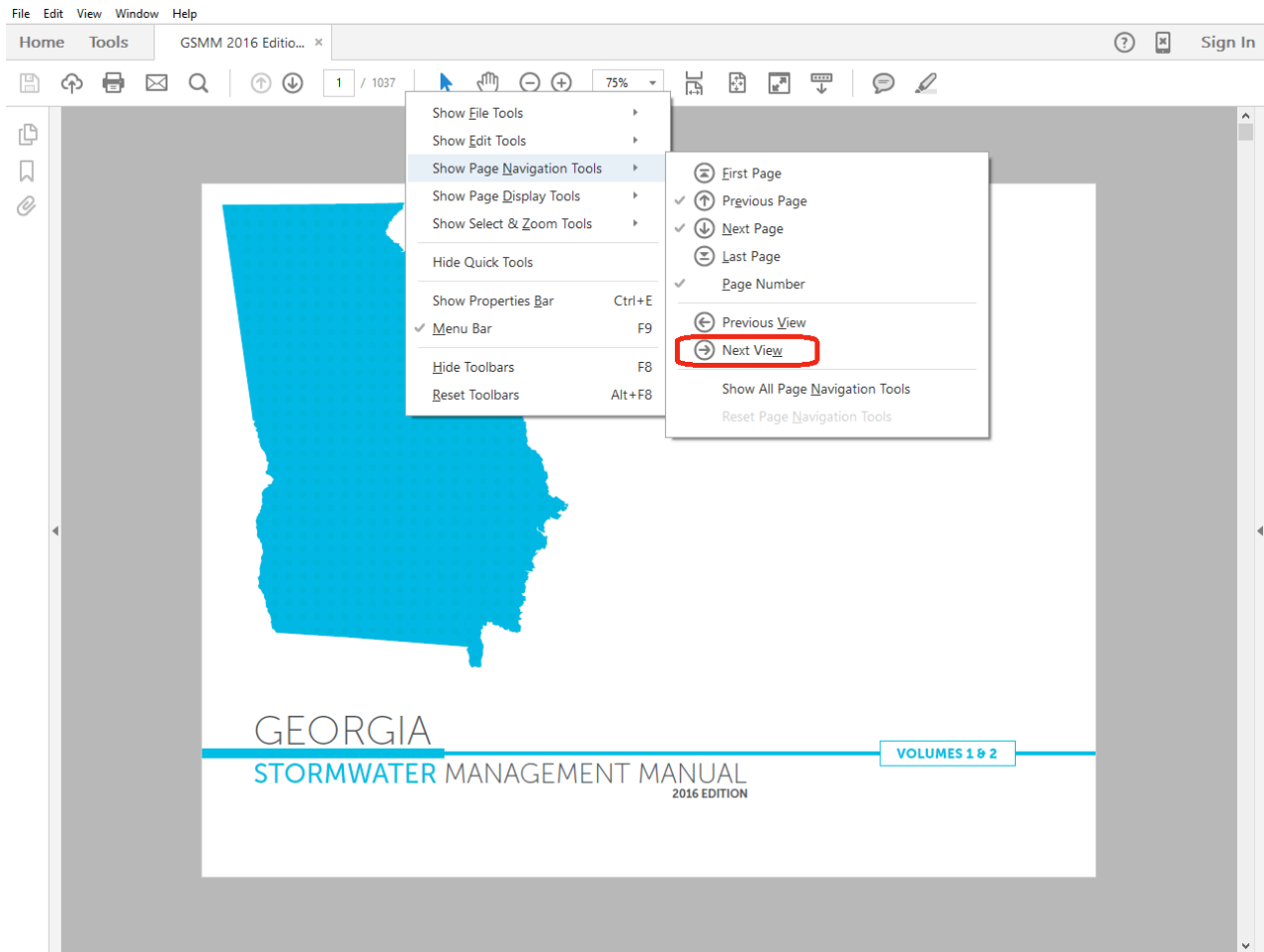
1) Open the document and locate the tool bar:



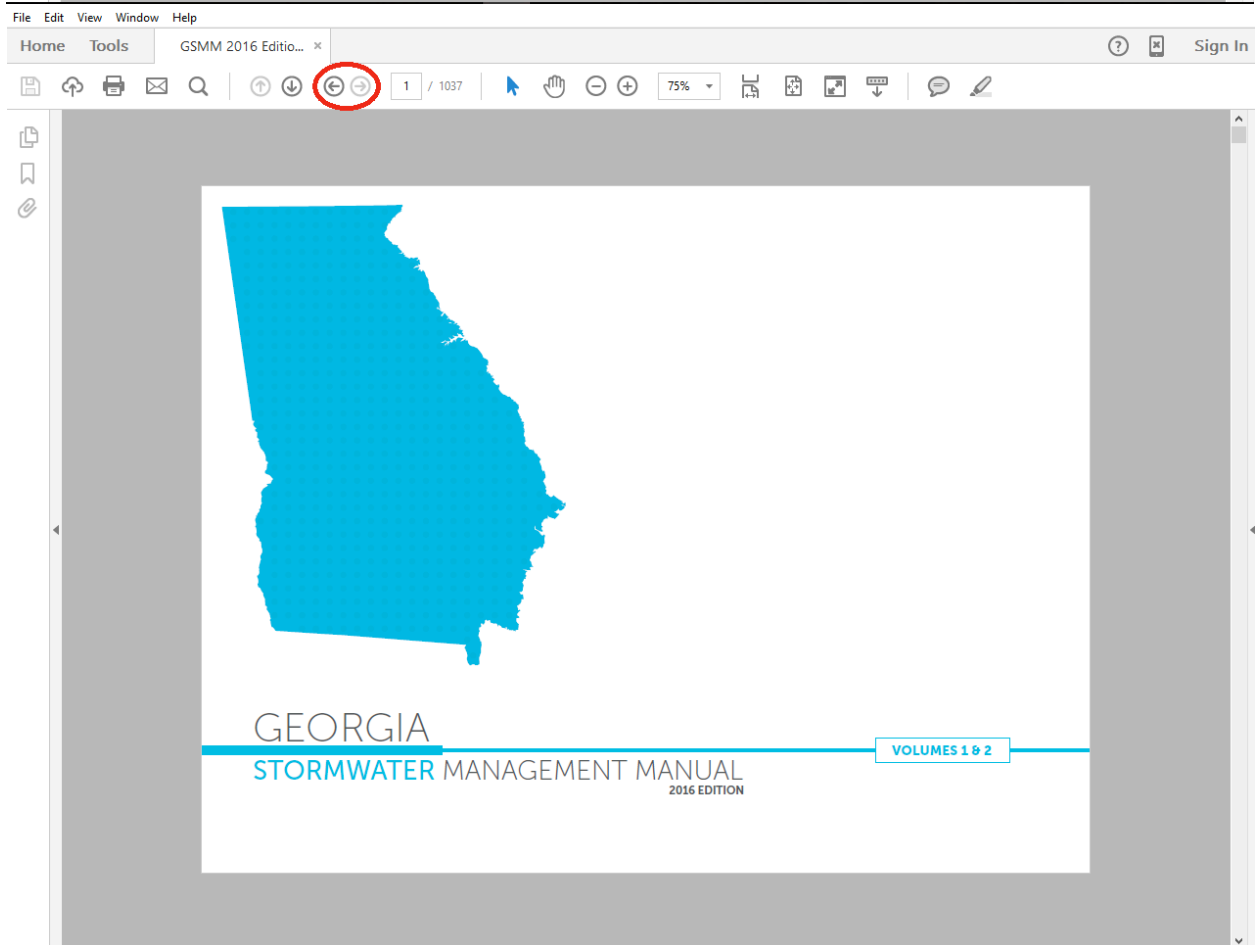
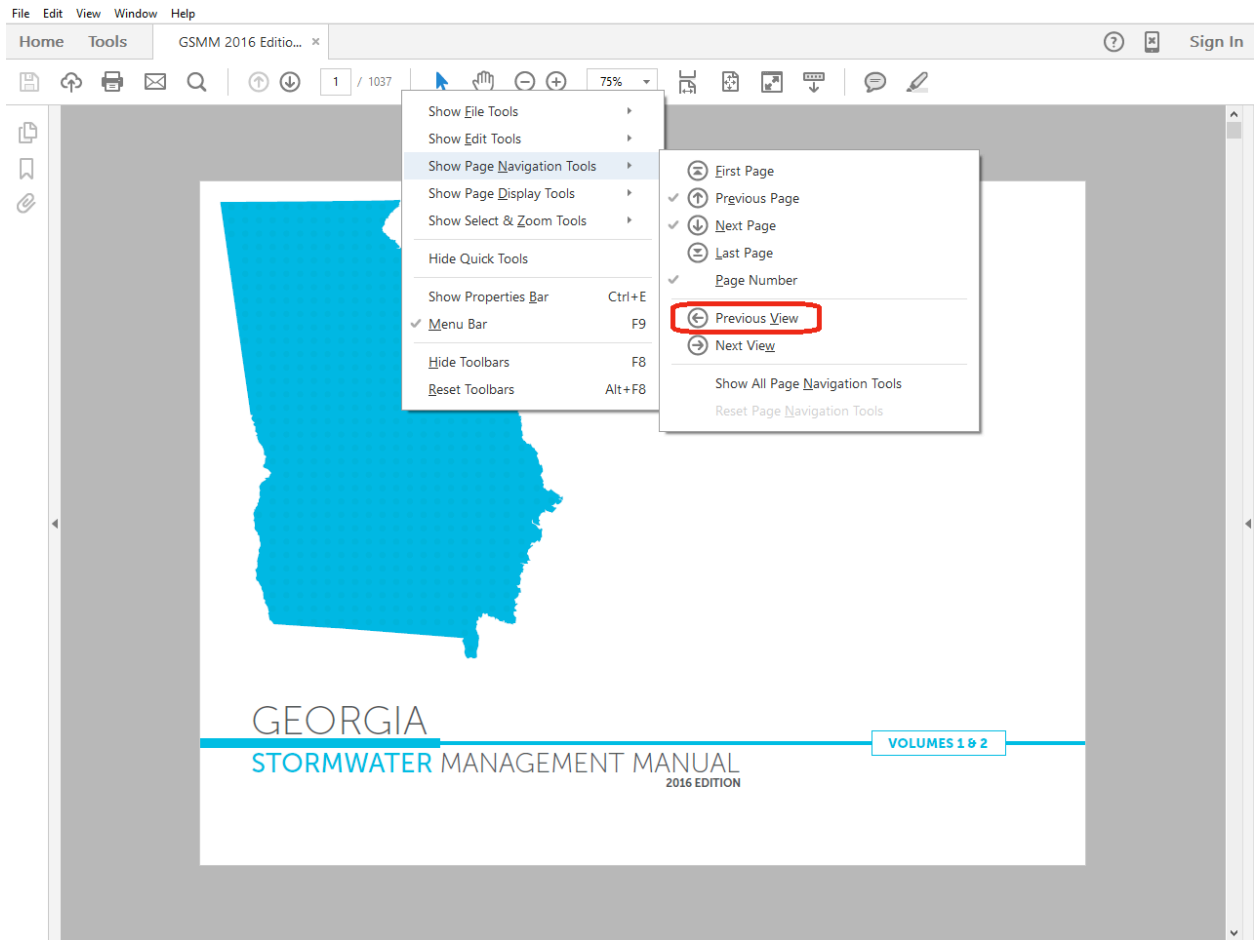
2) Right click on the tool bar and locate Show Page Navigation Tools



3) With the options boxes open, click on Next View and the next arrow will be displayed



4) Repeat Step 2 & 3 to display the Previous View arrow so that both arrows are now displayed



You will now be able to navigate around the pdf without having to return to the Table of Contents each time you use an embedded link. Note that this only works for links within the document, not links that take you outside the document. For external links, simply return to the document to pick-up where you've left off.
