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State Roadway Safety Targets for 2018



Previous Direction (September 2017)

- Agree to "program projects to support achievement of state targets"
- Investigate the feasibility and desirability of setting additional complementary measures and targets
 - What are our main safety issues?
 - Do we have good data to quantify the problem?
 - How do we define targets?
 - Can we make meaningful progress towards the target?



- Vote on safety targets resolution in February 2018
- Document process in a manner agreed upon by ARC, GDOT and transit providers by May 2018
- Continue to investigate additional safety measures and targets and provide status update by mid-2018
- Continue to coordinate with GDOT on remaining targets (state must set them by May 20, 2018)
