

What's in Amendment #4?

- 2017 TIP Project Solicitation Funding Commitments
 - Exempt projects only
 - Conformity projects to be handled during Amendment #5 (May 2018 adoption)
- Financial changes to Major Mobility Investment Program (MMIP) projects
- Other financial changes

2017 TIP Solicitation



- Followed-up with jurisdictions, where needed, to reconfirm project status and clarify project concept understanding
- Project delivery "check" review with GDOT Program Delivery and GDOT Program Control staff
- Worked with GDOT on reviewing potential CMAQ projects and assessing the deliverability of submitted projects
- Reviewed status of current TIP projects and adjusted financial balance of regional lump sum programs

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




EXAMPLE 10 2017 TIP Solicitation Funding Allocated by Local Priority



- Asked sponsors their priority for each project (ranked 1-5)
- 53% of funding is going towards top priority projects from local governments

PLAN 2017 TIP SolicitationFunding Allocated by Project Type



- Asset Management = 12%
- System Expansion = 88%

- Noonday Creek Trail Extension from SR 92 to Noonday Creek Park

- Xpress Park and Ride Lot Expansion
 - Sugarloaf
 - Rockdale

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2017 TIP Solicitation – Project Examples

Roadway Expansion

- Courtesy Parkway Extension/I-20 Overpass (Rockdale County)
- Rock Quarry Road from Eagles Landing Parkway to SR 42/ SR 138 (Henry County)

Transportation System Maintenance & Operations

- Peachtree Industrial Boulevard Smart Corridor (Gwinnett County)
- East Solomon Street Intersection Improvements at Spalding Street/ Searcy Avenue (City of Griffin)

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2017 TIP Solicitation – Project Examples

Asset Management

- Indian Trail Park and Ride (Gwinnett County)
- Forest Parkway Pavement Rehabilitation (Clayton County)
- Xpress Bus Maintenance and Rehabilitation

<u>Studies</u>

- Chattahoochee Greenway Trail Study
- Freight Cluster Plan
- Regional Smart Corridor Network Study and ITS Architecture Update
- Interchange upgrade & feasibility studies

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MMIP and Other Related Changes

- Fulfillment of GDOT TIP solicitation request for MPO funding on PE activities
 - I-285 at I-20 West Interchange
 - I-285 at I-20 East Interchange
 - I-285 West from I-75 to I-20 Express Lanes
 - I-285 East from I-85 to I-20 Express Lanes
- Removal of P3 funded phases & other financial adjustments
- National Highway Freight Performance Program funding for I-285 at SR 400 Interchange

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Other General Financial Changes

- Increase to federal funded phase
- Add new federal funded phase
- Add lump sum line item
- Advancement of phase from Long Range into TIP period
- Status change from Programmed to Long Range
- Fund source change from state to federal

PLAN Next Steps - TIP Solicitation

- New funds to be awarded via TIP Amendments
 - Forthcoming Amendment 5 to cover projects which require modeling
- Kickoff meeting for TIP Solicitation Awardees
 - Friday, February 9th (TCC)
 - ARC and GDOT staff will attend
 - Draft agenda:
 - TIP administration basics (how to submit change requests, TIP amendments vs administrative modifications, etc.)
 - Project administration tracks (studies, infrastructure, transit flex to FTA, etc.)
 - GDOT expectations (LAP certification, Project Framework Agreement development, schedule development, procurement requirements)
 - Q&A

 - Inclusion of TSPLOST/SPLOST Projects
- <u>Key Dates</u>
 - March GRTA Board First Read of Amendment 5
 - Mid-March to Mid-April 30-day Public Comment Period
 - May TCC/TAQC Action
 - May GRTA Conditional Action
 - Mid-May to Early June Conformity Determination from US DOT
 - Late May or Early June Updated RTP/TIP Project List Available
