



RTP Amendment and Admin Mod History

The Atlanta Regional Commission, as a federal grant recipient, conforms to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and its amendments. Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 requires that no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance. Presidential Executive Order 12898 addresses environmental justice in minority and low-income populations. Presidential Executive Order 13166 addresses services to those individuals with limited English proficiency.

ARC is committed to enforcing the provisions of Title VI and to taking positive and realistic affirmative steps to ensure the protection of rights and opportunities for all persons affected by its programs.

- Review of bonding, debt and P3 financial assumptions for MMIP
- Additional detail on tolling revenue and how funds are committed
- Ongoing review of current project scopes, schedules and budgets
- New priorities from current and recently completed planning studies
- More MARTA project cost and phasing details
- How the plan should address a still evolving ATL Authority
