

TIP Solicitation 2019

- TIP call for projects (solicitation) to fund projects in the forthcoming 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
- FHWA Fund Source Programs
 - Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG-Urban)
 - Setaside for LCI implementation
 - Transportation Alternatives (TAP)
 - Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ)
- Funds to be awarded for new TIP projects and phases, supplemental funding for existing TIP projects, and funding for TIP studies and related non-capital initiatives

Application Guidance

Studies and Non-Capital Application

- Funding for a new study
- Funding for activities that do not result in actual transportation infrastructure

Infrastructure Application

- Funding (\$2 million or more) for an existing TIP phase that was previously federally funded (e.g., cost increase)
- Funding to add a new project or phase to the TIP with one or more phases being federally funded for the first time

PLANIT Submission

- Funding (under \$2,000,000) for an existing ARC-funded project phase in the TIP
- Make submission through existing PLANIT credentials during application period





Guidance for Transit Projects

- Eligible Project Types
 - Capital and Preventive Maintenance
 - Bus Procurement
 - Service Expansion
 - Station Area Access (first-mile and last-mile connections)
- Flex Projects (Fund Transfer from FHWA to FTA)
 - Demonstrate transit nexus and described clearly in scope of work
 - If sponsor is not a FTA direct recipient, must partner with a direct recipient to submit application into TRAMS







- Application Period Opens August 12, 2019
 - Applicant Helpdesk at ARC September 6, 2019
- Application Period Closes October 11, 2019
- Project Evaluation October through November 2019
- Draft Recommendations 1st Quarter 2020
- Final Recommendations Late 1st Quarter 2020/2nd Quarter 2020
- Award Incorporation into TIP 2nd Quarter 2020
