High-level Summary of Major TAQC Work Activities for 2021 (not exhaustive list)

- Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendments
- Discuss the impact of the Pandemic on regional transportation (teleworking, transit, congestion) and how this impacts the region.
- Begin the next Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) update later in the calendar year.
- Begin meetings of the TAQC Subcommittees in March:
 1. Policy Subcommittee
 2. Regional Transit Subcommittee

Several Major Regional Transportation Initiatives are Beginning in 2021 (examples)

- **Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Plan** – With the travel changes created by the Pandemic, how should our regional policies evolve relating to remote working and other areas?
- **Safety Action Plan** – Serious challenges continue in addressing crashes.
- **Freight and Goods Movement Plan Update** – The fastest growing component of overall travel. Major growth in goods movement has occurred since the last Freight Plan update.
