2020 Urban Area Information Released by the Census Bureau on December 29th

- Designated by US Census Bureau following each Census
- Based on census housing density, other factors
- Developed using an automated program
- Forms the basis of the multi-county MPO planning area
- Impacts both planning and project funding (populationbased)
- Based on the new 2020 census results:
 - 17 Urban Areas over 50,000 population designated in Georgia
 - Urban Area identified in the Winder area
 - Atlanta urban area population has increased:

• 2010: 4,515,419

• 2020: 4,999,259



Follow-up and Next Steps

- Boundary released in late January
- Adjusting the MPA creates technical challenges (examples):
 - Travel demand model expansion
 - Population/Employment forecasting tools (REMI, PECAS)
- Potential Impacts to Planning Committees
 - Technical
 - Policy
