Why is Amendment 5 Required?

- Advancement of a federal funded phase from Long Range to TIP period (or vice versa)
- Increasing the cost of existing project phases in excess of \$4 million or 40% more than current total phase cost
- Adding a new federal-funded project to the TIP

- Advancing project phases from federal recognized Long Range years to TIP years (between FY 2024-2027)
- Project phase change from a local or state fund source to a federal fund source
- Addition of new projects that are either considered exempt or non-exempt from air quality conformity analysis
- Deletion of federal funded projects exempt from air quality analysis
- Adjustments to the travel demand model which includes changes to project network model years or termini points of conformity projects
- Project cost estimate and programmatic changes that are of a time sensitive nature or cannot be handled administratively.





Public Comment Period

- A public comment period was held from September 24 through October 23
 - No written public comments were received during this time
- A public hearing was held on October 8th during the Joint Transportation and Air Quality Committee/ARC Board meeting.
 - No verbal public comments were received during this hearing.
