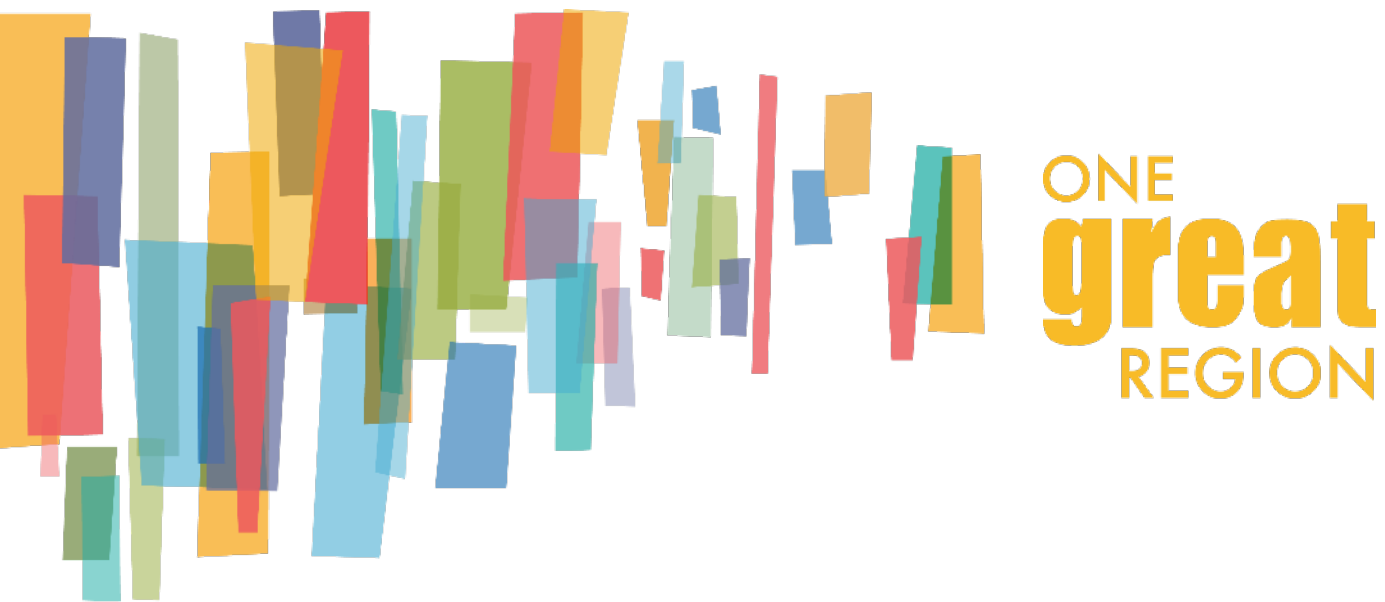

What is the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)?

- Short range element of Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)
- Contains a list transportation projects that have federal funds programmed on one or more project phase within the fiscal years of a TIP
- Current TIP covers fiscal years 2024-2027 – but ARC is currently working on a FY 2027-2030 TIP

Federal Fund Sources – ARC Programmed

- ARC is apportioned federal funds from the following programs:
 - Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Program– Urban (Pop >200K) **(STBG Urban)**
 - Approximately \$110 million per fiscal year*
 - Transportation Alternatives Program– Urban (Pop >200K) **(TAP)**
 - Approximately \$16.5 million per fiscal year*
 - Carbon Reduction Program – Urban (Pop >200K) **(CRP)**
 - Approximately \$13.5 million per fiscal year*
- Formerly, ARC would provide funding recommendations to GDOT for their CMAQ program. Going forward, GDOT will be administering the CMAQ call for projects.*

TIP Project Solicitation Process

- ARC opens a call for project proposals **December 2025**
- Applications due **January 2026**
- Applications run through KDP evaluation process **January – May 2026**
- Award notices issued **June 2026**
- Anticipated board action and inclusion in TIP **November 2026**

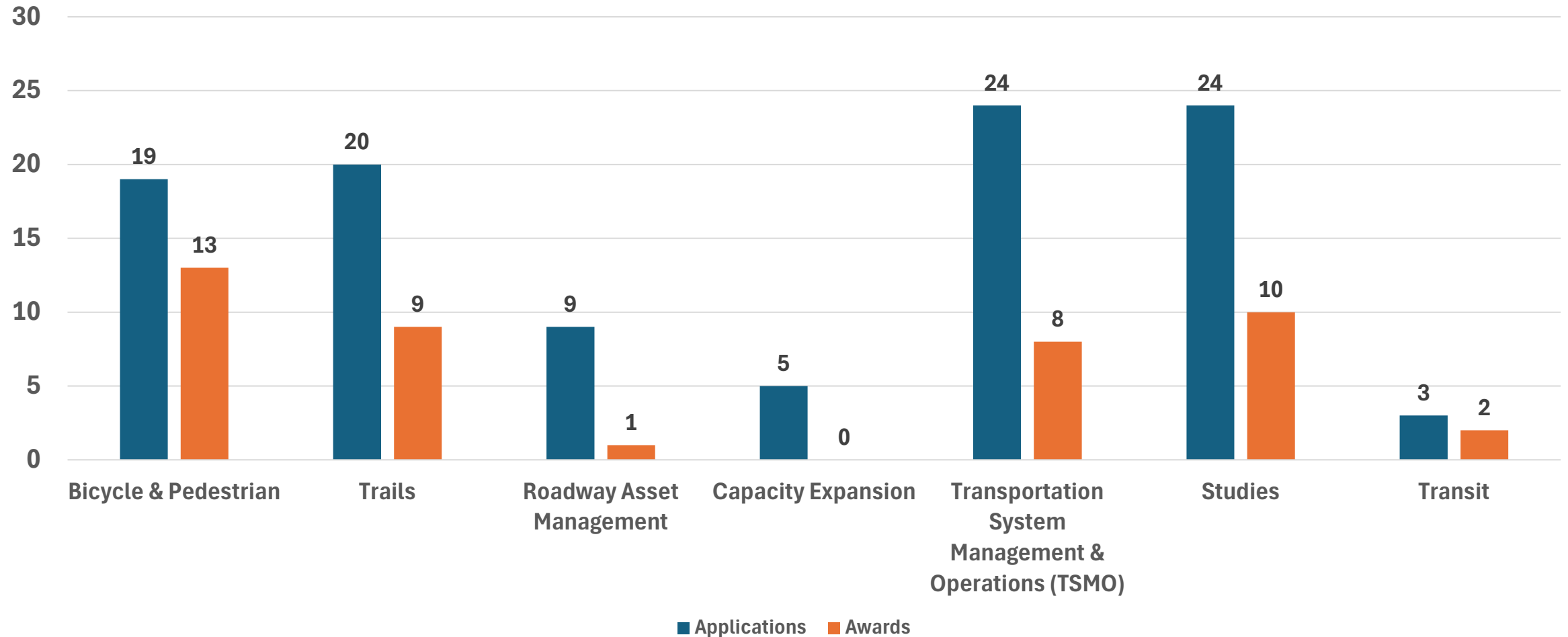

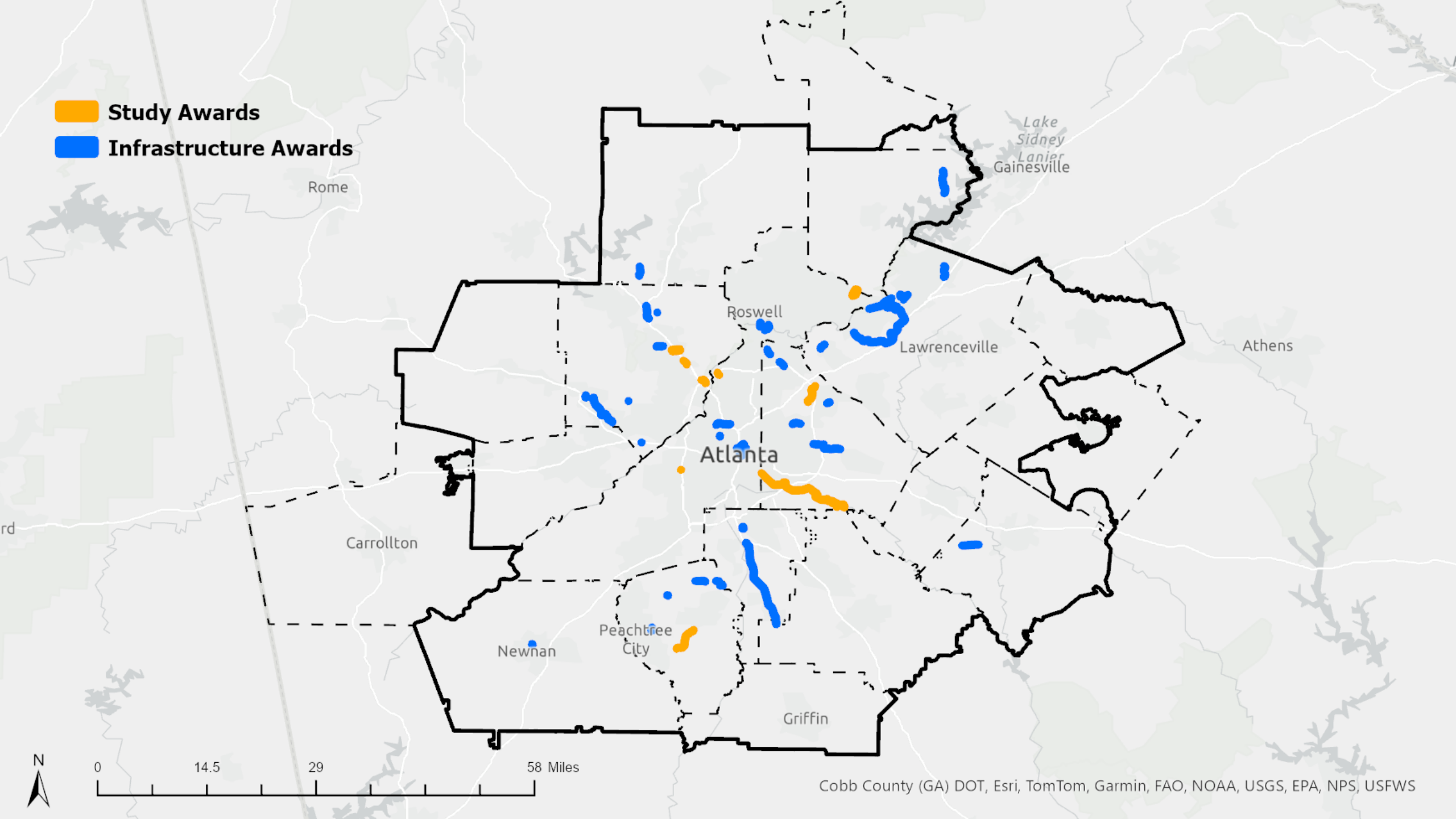

Application Counts and Awards



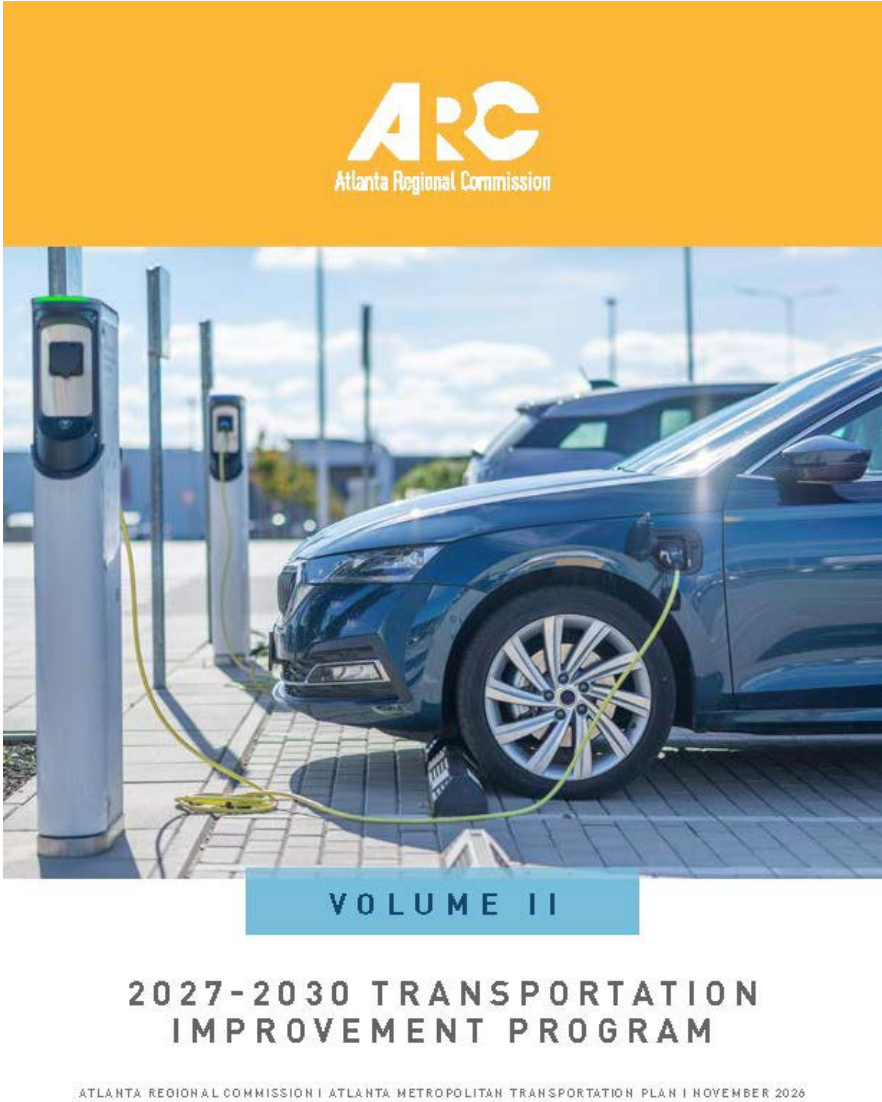

The FY 2027-2030 Transportation Improvement Program

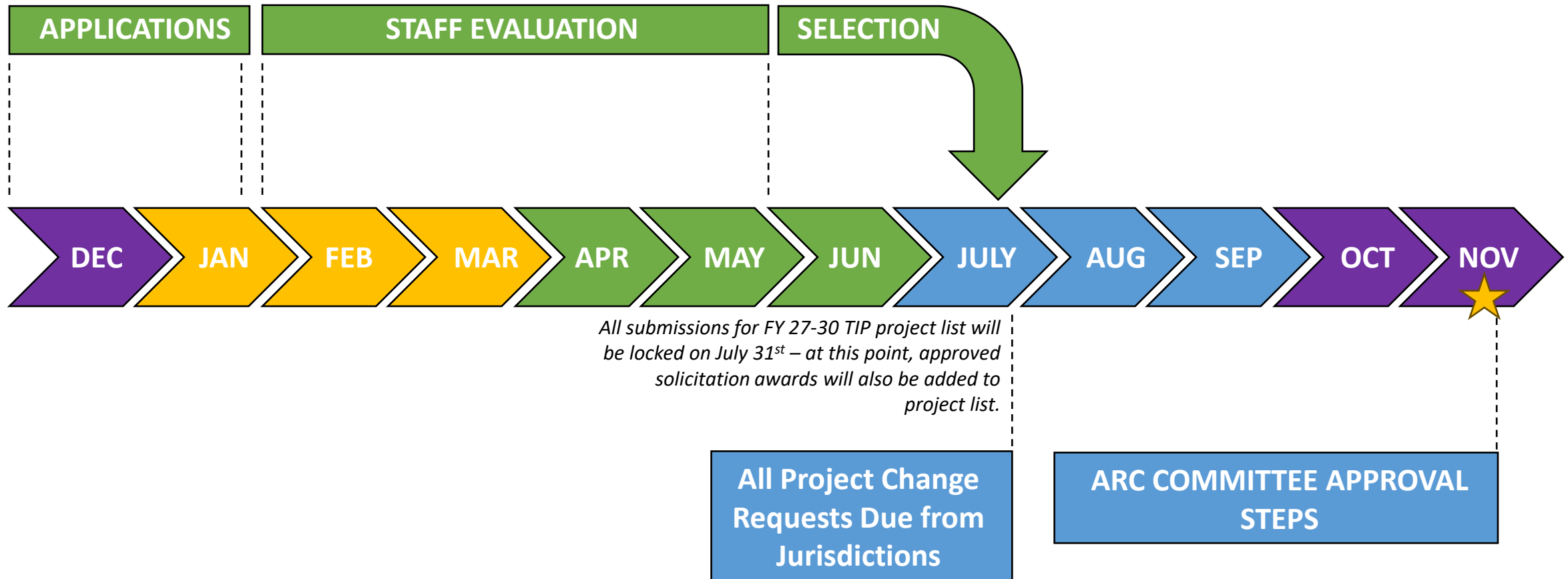

ARC Board/TAQC Action	November 12

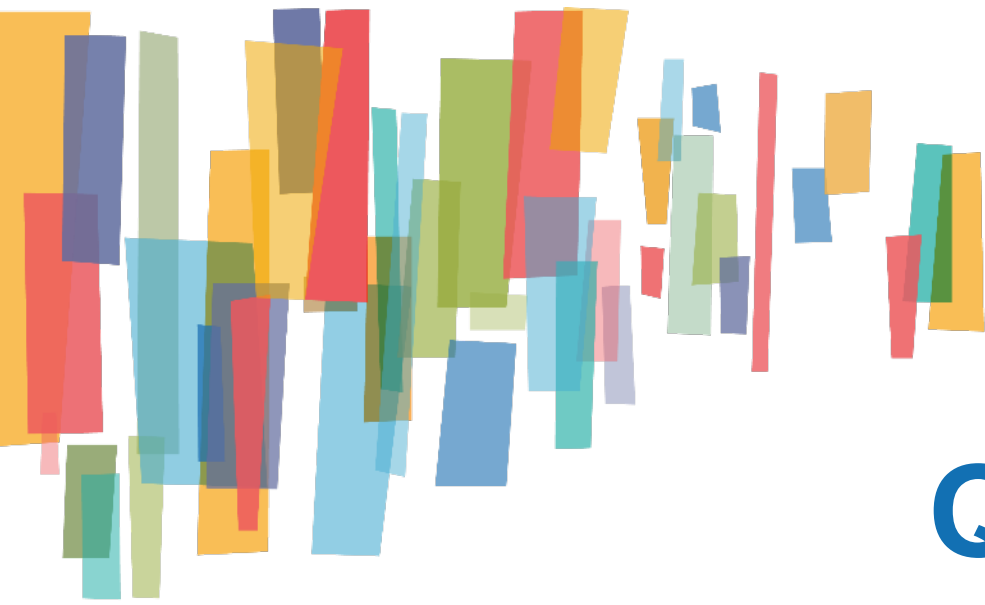


Solicitation/TIP Adoption Timeline
