Mobility 2055: Planning the Future of Transportation in Metro Atlanta

Metro Atlanta is growing rapidly, and the transportation decisions we make today will shape how people and goods move throughout our region for decades to come. Mobility 2055 is the Atlanta Regional Commission's (ARC) Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) that will guide transportation investments across the 19-county metro Atlanta region through the year 2055.

What is Mobility 2055?

Mobility 2055 is the region's blueprint for transportation investments and priorities. The plan will help determine how federal and state transportation funding is invested to improve:

- Roads and Highways
- Public Transit
- Walking and Biking Infrastructure
- Freight Movement
- Transportation Safety
- Regional Mobility and Connectivity

The plan also includes the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which identifies priority projects expected to receive federal funding over the next four years.

Why It Matters

As metro Atlanta continues to grow, thoughtful transportation planning is essential to:

- Reduce congestion
- Improve safety
- Expand transportation choices
- Connect people to jobs and opportunities
- Support economic growth
- Strengthen environmental sustainability and resilience
- Ensure transportation investments meet the needs of tomorrow's residents, businesses, and visitors

How Mobility 2055 Aligns with Regional Priorities

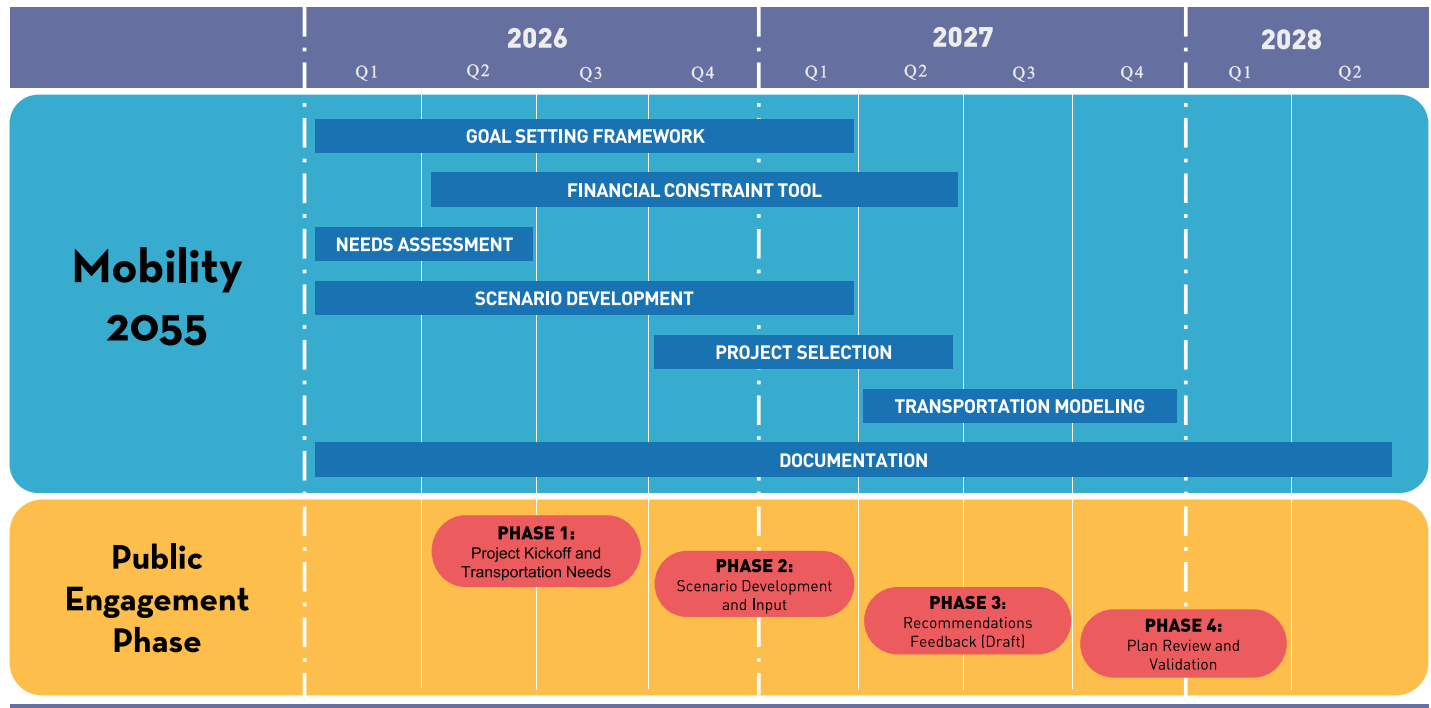
Mobility 2055 will closely align with the ARC's broader planning efforts to ensure a coordinated, forward-looking approach to growth and infrastructure. It works in tandem with ongoing regional initiatives, including the Regional Development Plan, Regional Bicycle and Trail Plan, and the Metro Atlanta Climate Action Plan, while building on previous planning efforts like local Comprehensive Transportation Plans (CTP's) to create a more connected, sustainable, and resilient region.

By integrating these efforts, Mobility 2055 will support improved air quality for the region through initiatives such as: expanding multimodal transportation options, informing future land use decisions, reducing travel delay, and advancing climate and environmental goals. This alignment ensures that transportation investments not only improve mobility, but also reinforce the region's long-term vision for livability, health, and economic prosperity.



Mobility 2055 Plan Development Schedule

Mobility 2055 will be presented to the Transportation & Air Quality Committee and ARC Board in early 2028 for adoption. In the time leading up to adoption, the project team will be working on various tasks and engaging with diverse stakeholders on this major MTP update!



How Mobility 2055 will Engage with the Public

Public engagement is a critical component of developing Mobility 2055, ensuring that the plan reflects the needs, priorities, and values of the region's residents and stakeholders. Engagement will occur in four key phases throughout the planning process:

Phase 1: Project Kickoff and Transportation Needs

Introduces the MTP process and gathers input on current transportation challenges, needs, and opportunities across the region.

Phase 2: Scenario Development and Impact

Engages the public in exploring different future scenarios and understanding how various investment strategies could impact mobility, communities, and the environment.

Phase 3: Draft Recommendations Feedback

Presents proposed projects and strategies, providing opportunities for stakeholders to review and share feedback to help refine the plan.

Phase 4: Plan Review and Validation

Shares the near-final plan and confirms that it reflects community input, ensuring transparency and accountability before adoption.
