2. **Community Planning Academy: Economic Development 101** *Andrew Smith, ARC*

ARC's Community Planning Academy (CPA) recently offered Economic Development 101, a half-day virtual training designed to assist planners and other stakeholders with their understanding of economic development. Participants explored goals, tools, and activities to better connect planning and economic development efforts in their communities. Andrew Smith of ARC's Community Development Group will talk about the training and how it fits into the broader CPA program.

Allison Stewart-Harris of VHB will give an update on the Clayton County High-Capacity Transit Supportive Land Use Study to provide an update on the study, and the next steps the jurisdictions can take to implement the recommendations. The study builds up numerous LCI land use studies previously funded by the ARC.

The Cost-of-Living Index, produced by the Council for Community and Economic Research, provides a point-in-time snapshot of how cities across America compare to one another in everything from overall cost of living to housing and ibuprofen. As in previous years, Atlanta is on par with the rest of the country's current cost of living. The snapshot presents overall findings alongside Consumer Price Index data to show how current average costs in Atlanta compare to those in years past.
