Plan Summary


- » The Atlanta region's request to the state to access federal funding through Older Americans Act and state funding for aging services:
 - ARC is requesting \$18,772,627 for FY 2019
- » Supports Regional Strategic Priorities
- » Includes an annual budget detailing how region will use the funds
- » Follows state and federal restrictions and guidelines on what can be funded at what level
- » Not inclusive of Aging and Health Resources entire scope of work; only Older Americans Act and related state funding.
- » Provides funding for regional and local services
