## 01 21-County Data Dashboard

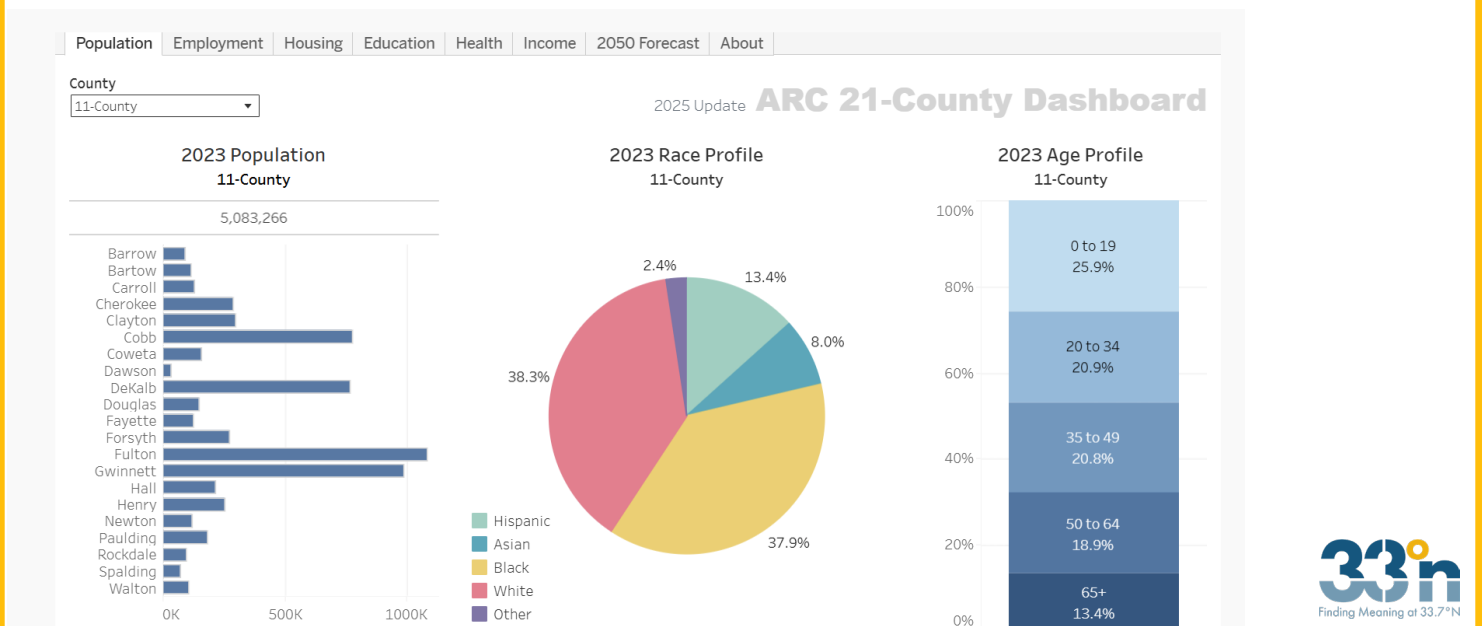
**Level of Detail:** Summary-Level Dashboard
