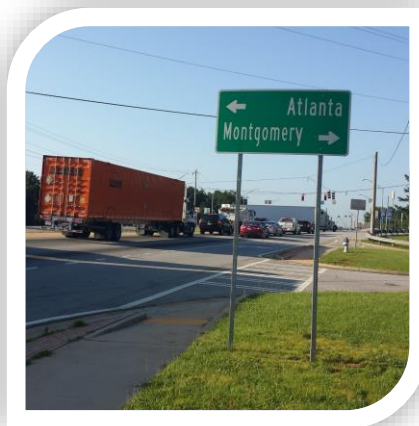

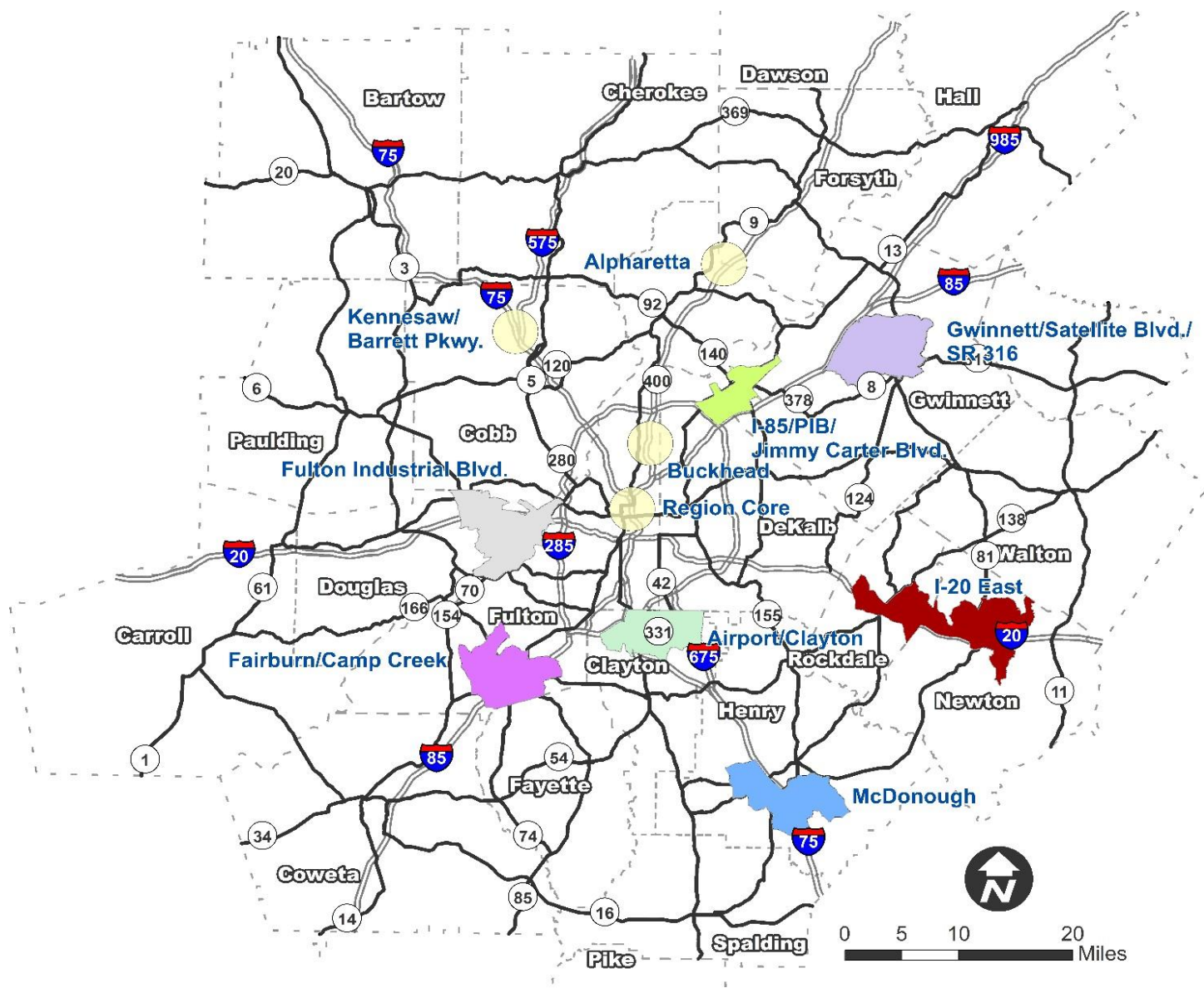

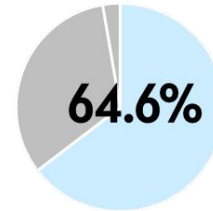

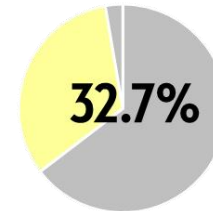

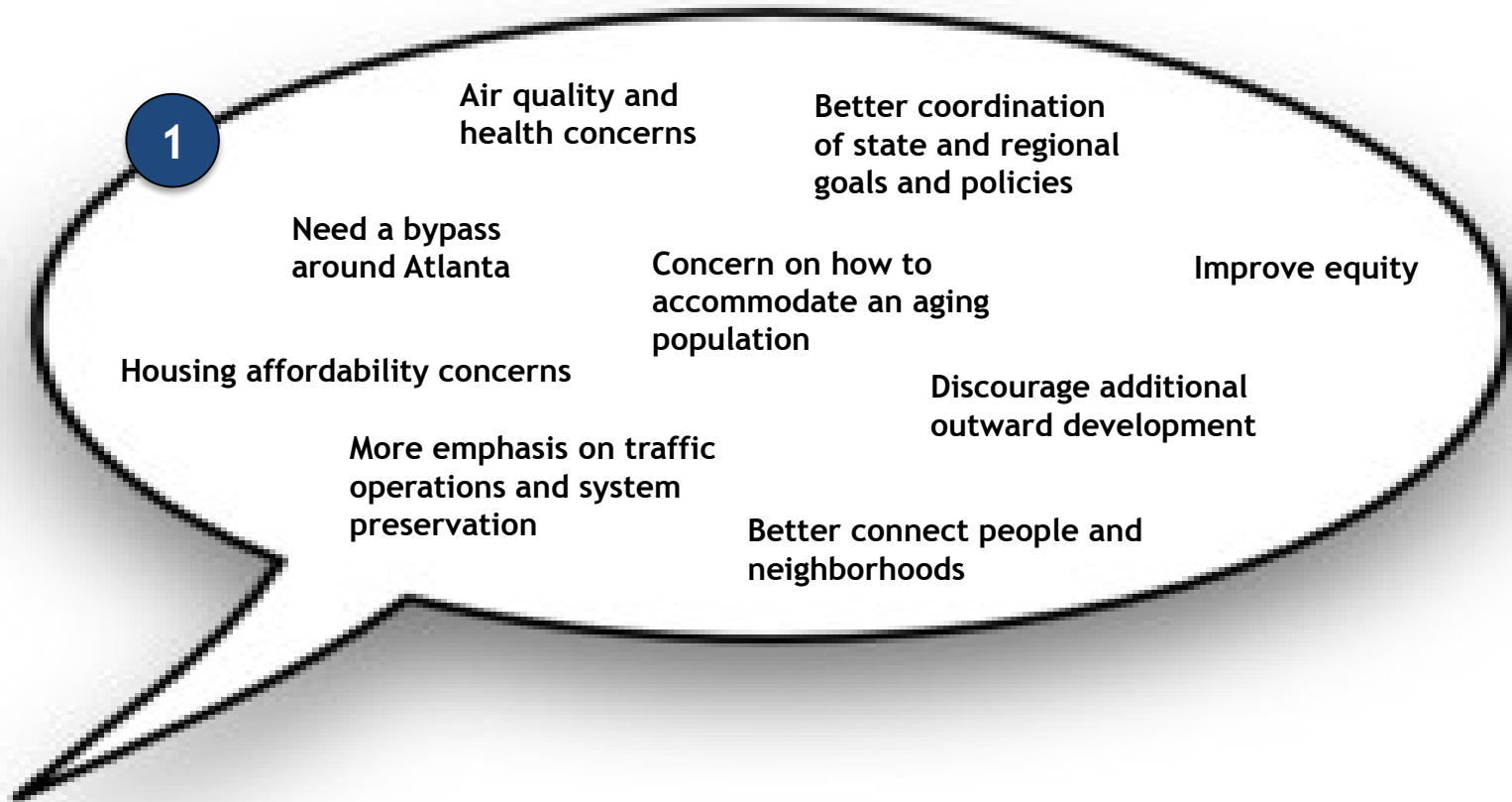

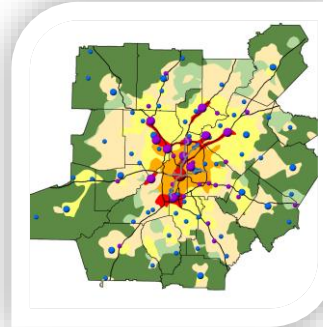


# Phase III survey results show good support for key plan concepts

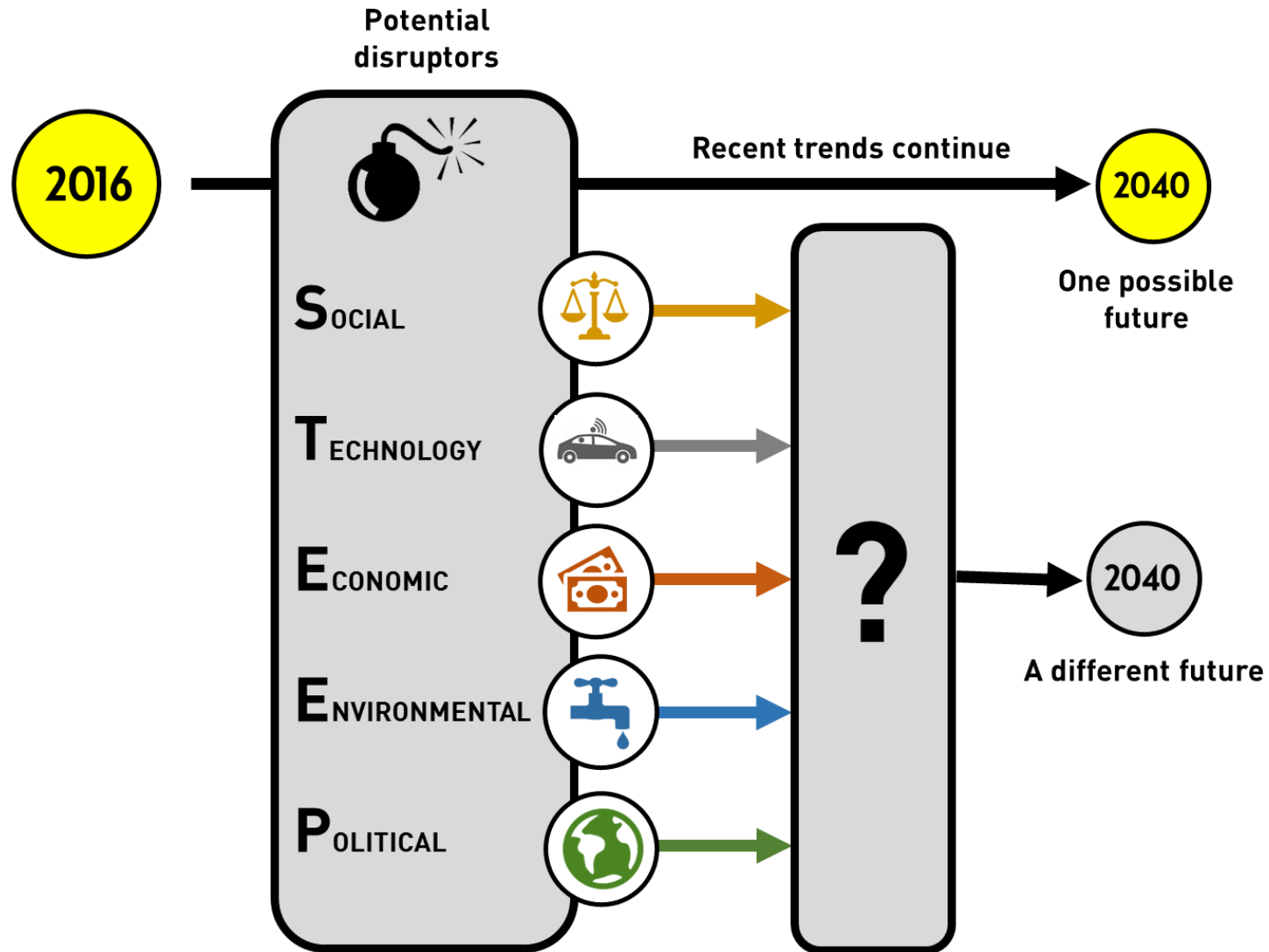
