Why a Coordinated Human Services Transportation Plan?





 Federal transit law requires projects selected for funding under the Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities (Section 5310) Program be "included in a locally developed, coordinated public transit-human services transportation plan"

Federal transit law requires the CHST plan be "developed and approved through a process that includes participation by seniors, individuals with disabilities, representatives of public, private, and nonprofit transportation and human services providers and other members of the public" using transportation services, typically "Paratransit"


