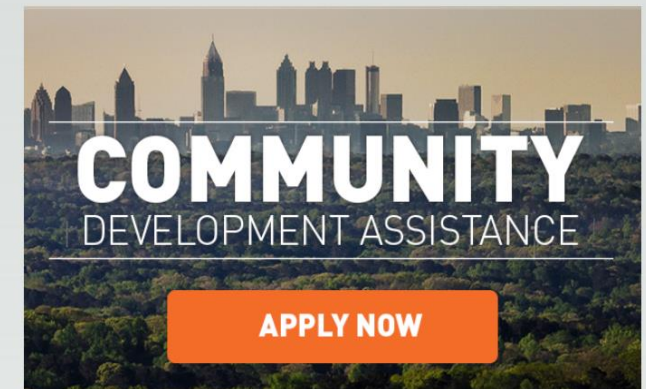
Call for Projects – Apply Now
