

SR 237 (Piedmont Road) between Sidney Marcus Boulevard and Garson Drive in City of Atlanta - Pedestrian Safety Improvements

\$80,000 Federal / \$20,000 Local Match (Scoping / Engineering Only)

Midblock crossing on a Regional Thoroughfare between MARTA Lindbergh rail station and residential/commercial developments





SR 11 at Apalachee River in Walton County – Bridge Replacement

\$2,074,000 Federal / \$518,500 State Match

Bridge is located on a Regional Thoroughfare and ASTRoMaP corridor serving north/south travel on eastern edge of region.





SR 6 (Thornton Road) from I-20 in Douglas County to Garrett Road in Cobb County - Truck Navigation and Safety Improvements

\$1,476,000 Federal / \$369,000 Local Match

ASTRoMaP corridor and Regional Thoroughfare corridor linking I-20, intermodal yard in Austell; key commute route for Paulding County
