Welcome and Introductions

UPS Innovation and Urban Delivery

Frank Morris, UPS Public Affairs, will discuss innovative ways UPS is delivering our packages, as well as some of the challenges with urban deliveries. Last week UPS announced they will begin deploying electric delivery trucks in Atlanta and two other cities nationally. With the growth of e-commerce and increasing density in activity centers throughout the region, alternative fuels and other innovations will be key to managing this growth in the future.

South Fulton CID Multimodal Study

The South Fulton Community Improvement District (CID), using funds from an ARC federal grant and a local match, kicked this study off in late 2016 and are working to finalize recommendations now. The study area includes the CSX Fairburn intermodal facility, Oakley Industrial Boulevard, and the surrounding area in the cities of Fairburn, Union City, Palmetto, and South Fulton. CID and consultant staff will present their study process and the draft recommendations for this plan.
