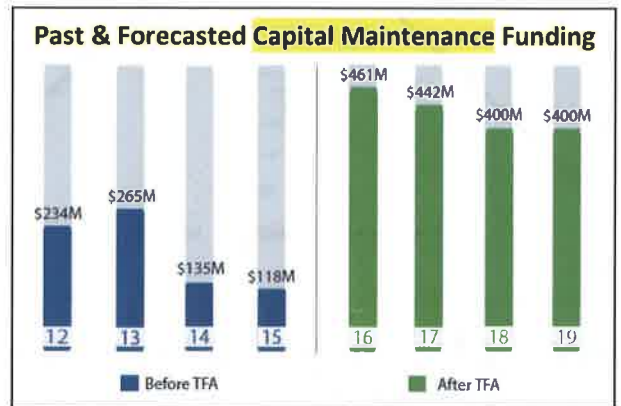
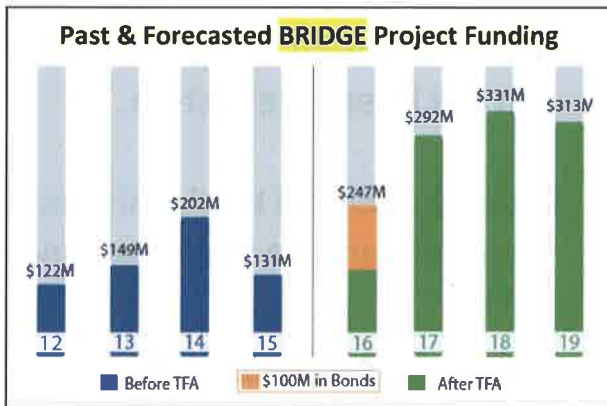
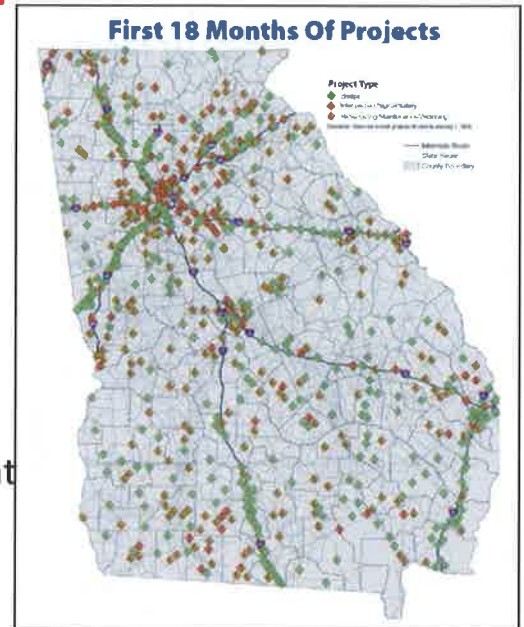


TRANSPORTATION FUNDING ACT IMPLEMENTATION

- ✓ Using H.B. 170 Funding To Take Care of our Existing Roadway First & Foremost!
 - To Be Contracted over NEXT 18 MONTHS
 - Over 2,500 miles in roadway resurfacing
 - Replacing 118 bridges
 - Rehabilitating & maintaining 300+ bridges
 - Hundreds of safety projects: signals, intersections, signs, & guardrail replacement
 - Widening 36 roadways
- ✓ 20% increase to local government grants (LMIG)

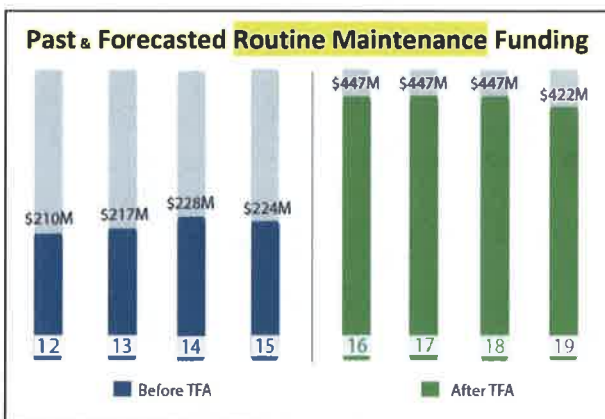


Bridges

- ✓ Funding nearly **DOUBLED** in FY16
- ✓ **More than DOUBLED** by FY17
- ✓ **Nearly TRIPLED** by FY18
- ✓ Repairing & replacing State AND local bridges.

Road Resurfacing

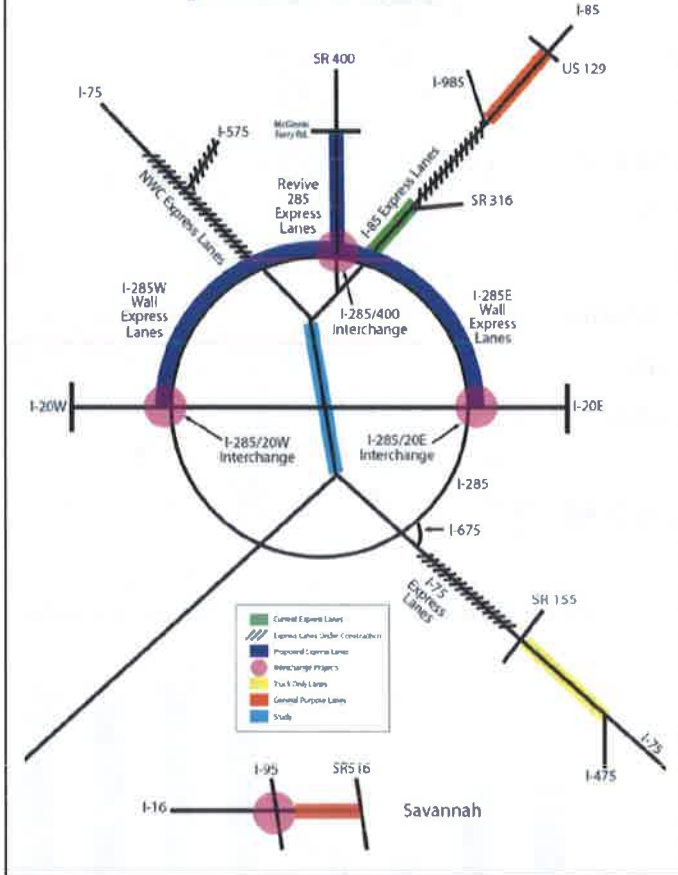
- ✓ Funding for roadway resurfacing is nearly **QUADRUPLED** in FY16.



Preventative (Routine) Maintenance

- ✓ Funding nearly **DOUBLED** in FY16
- ✓ Pavement preservation: crack filling, pot hole repair, concrete slab repair, etc.
- ✓ Stripes and guardrail repair
- ✓ Clearing right-of-way & roadway of obstructions to improve safety

Innovative Financing for Major Projects

→ Using successes of I-285/400 and the NW Corridor Projects as blueprints, Design-Build-Finance offers a way forward to advance major projects.

→ Critical projects to provide mobility relief in the Metro Area and at the Port could be underway in the next 10 years:

- Expansion of the managed lane system to provide commuter and transit (Xpress Bus) options.
- Reconstructing major interchanges on the interstate system.
- Adding optional truck only lanes and general purpose lanes for congestion relief.

Preparing for Economic & Freight Growth

→ Preparing for the continued increase of freight traffic throughout the state as the port is deepened and businesses continue to locate in Georgia.

→ Advance to construction 45 projects to complete corridors or portions of corridors of the freight network throughout the state.
