




### Northern Georgia in Abnormally Dry to Extreme Drought


### One Year Ago Northern Georgia in Abnormally Dry to Moderate Drought



#### Tracking Rainfall Throughout Georgia

While much of the state has received above-normal precipitation (normal is defined as an average over the past 30-years), much of the metro region remains in drought. Winter rains have failed to reflii Lake Lanier, which remains about eight feet below full pool.

#### Tracking rainfall throughout Georgia







### 2016/2017 Lowest Inflow on Record for Period from October - April





#### Three Active ACF Lawsuits

- Florida v. Georgia, No. 142 Original (US Supreme Court)
- Alabama v. US Army Corps of Engineers
- National Wildlife Federation v. US Army Corps of Engineers
  - Plantiffs also include the Florida Wildlife Federation, and the Apalachicola Bay and River Keeper
  - Represented by Earth Justice (the group formerly known as Sierra Club Legal Defense)
