Misti Martin and Gregg Simon will provide an overview of The Atlanta Regional Marketing Alliance, formed out of the Atlanta Regional Commission's Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy and consisting of the 10 Metro Atlanta Counties in the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC), City of Atlanta (Invest Atlanta), Metro Atlanta Chamber, Georgia Power Company, and Georgia Department of Economic Development. They will highlight some of The Alliance's partnerships, projects, and successes.
