FY 19 Older Americans Act funding increases for ARC

- **>** \$3,016,527
 - net increase Georgia Division of Aging Services grant
 - 16% increase for Atlanta region
 - Compared to FY 2018 grant

➤ Uses include:

- Provider network increases to existing service + innovation (84%)
- Increase ARC capacity to provide services and support service administration (16%)
 - Services include: ADRC counseling, Behavioral Health Coaching, Diabetes Coaching Pilot (innovation with ARCHI)
