

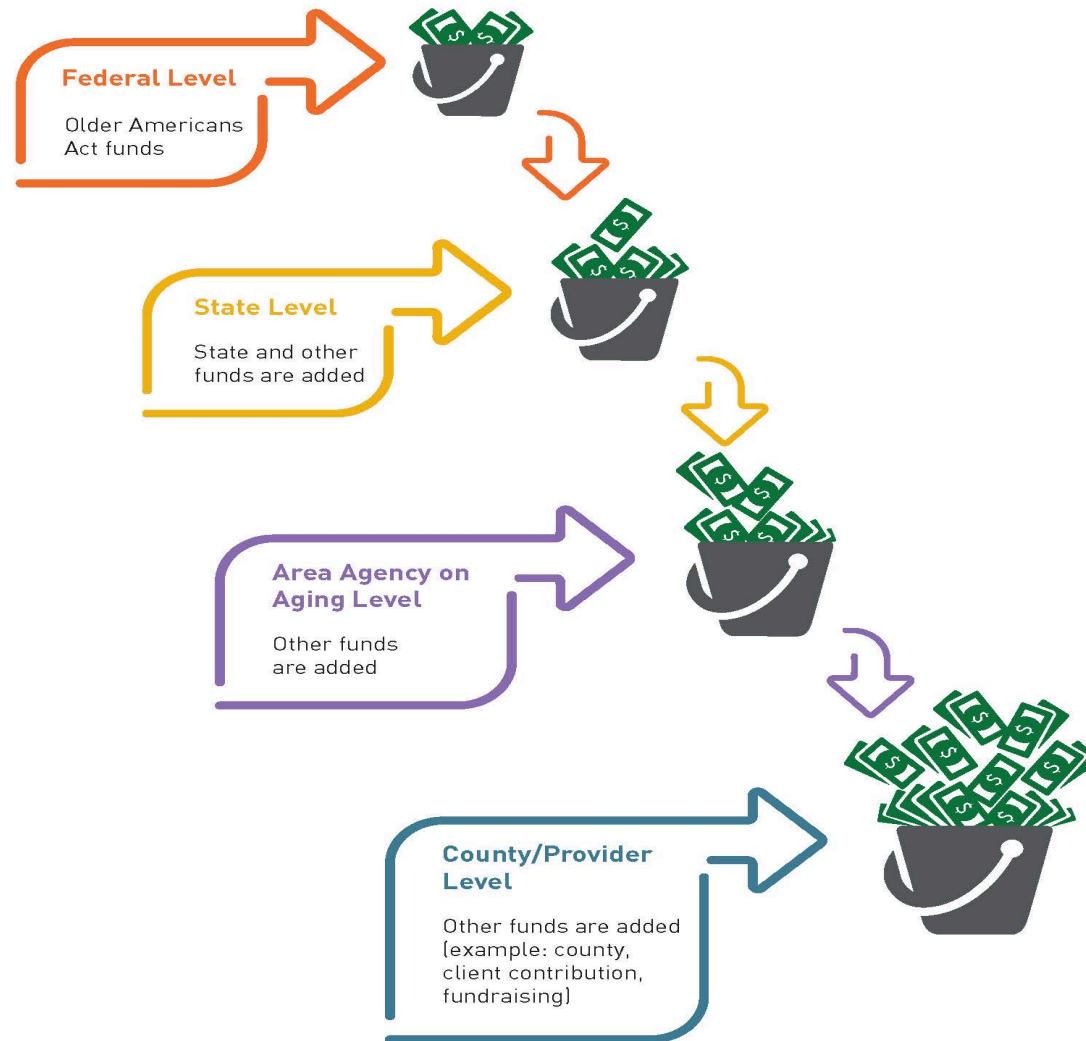
ARC 2023-24 Notification of Funding Availability(NOFA)



Purpose

- ARC is the recipient of funds for the region that are distributed by the State Unit on Aging
- ARC issues two NOFA'S one for single county services and the other for multi-county/regional services
- This money allows agencies who already provide services to submit proposals to receive additional funds to provide more and to leverage their own funds to make the dollars go further
- Through the use of this procurement and evaluation process, ARC funds subgrantees to provide the services for FY23 and with a one year renewal for FY24 based on satisfactory performance

How Older Americans Act Seed Money Grows



Services: Single County

- Home Delivered Meals *
- Congregate Meals *
- Personal Care*
- Homemaker *
- Caregiver Services*
- Case Management*
- Transportation*
- Senior Recreation
- Kinship Care -case management, community and public education support groups and conferences

Services: Multi-County/Regional

- Caregiver Services - may be a pass-through respite voucher program
- Kinship Care (case management, community and public education support groups and conferences)
- Congregate Meals
- Senior Recreation
- Elder Legal Assistance Program (ELAP)(Regional only)
- Culturally Appropriate Information and Referral to Individuals of limited English proficiency - will be a partner with Atlanta's Aging and Disability Resource Connection (ADRC)
- Culturally Appropriate Home Delivered Meal Service - NEW
- Case Management

Multi-County/Regional NOFA

Culturally Appropriate Home Delivered Meal Service

- Designed to meet the needs of specific ethnic populations
- If awarded, it may require a waiver from the state because the food products that are culturally appropriate may not meet the established guidelines for dietary requirements. ARC will work with provider to secure the waiver from the state.

Tips

- When filling out budget sheets, make sure to know:
 - Your raw food costs if meals are made in house
 - If you contract with a vendor, know the breakdown of their raw food cost and their operation cost. This is required for contracting
 - Which staff are associated with which programs
 - What percentage of staff time goes to each program
- Refer to UCM Training Manual for specific instructions
- Never wait for the last hour of the last day to upload your application.
