












The fiscally constrained plan includes over \$85 billion of investments over the next 25 years




The draft plan was open for public comment between December 7, 2015 and January 15, 2016






A total of 24 written comments were received during the comment period

Note that the numbers shown below add up to more than 24 since some comments covered more than one topic.






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Phase III of Online Survey Series





