


Anticipated Schedule (*subject to change)







Project Evaluation Flowchart ("KDPs")








KDP1 Policy Filters

- Project must originate from an adopted plan (Comp Plan, LCI Plan, CTP, other local plan)
- 2. QLG Status (or pending)
- 3. Locally Administered Project (LAP) Certified (or pending)
- 4. Eligible for federal aid and eligible applicant
- 5. Certain criteria for transit and roadway expansion projects

KDP 3 - LCI Criteria

LCI Plan Implementation – 25 Points

- Mixed-Use Zoning
- Multi-family permitted
- Incentives for workforce or affordable housing
- Connectivity requirements
- Parking limits or reduced requirements
- Historic District
- Buildings and entrances front street/sidewalks
- Design Overlay District

Complete Streets & Walkability – 30 Points

- Bike Facility
- Pedestrian Facility
- Safety Features





KDP 3 - LCI Criteria, Cont.

Innovation & Quality of Scope – 15 Points

- Green infrastructure
- Innovative or "smart" design elements
- Creative placemaking elements

Access to Transit – 15 Points

- TOD project
- ¼ mile from station or bus stop
- ½ from station or bus stop
- 1 mile or less from station or stop
- Adjacent to future transit

Social Equity – 15 Points

- Access to affordable housing
- Equitable Target Areas





KDP 4 - Project Delivery Assessment


Judged on a Pass/Fail basis.

Projects that fail deliverability assessment, but score well on KDP 2 & 3, may receive planning funds to better scope their project.

- 1. Environmental Screening
 - a) Alternatives considered
 - b) Coordination (railroad, utilities, multi-jurisdiction, etc)
 - c) NEPA impacts historic, ecology, archaelogy, air, noise, etc.
 - d) Public involvement/support
- 2. Design Information
 - a) Existing and proposal design features
 - b) ROW parcels, anticipated easements and displacements
 - c) Traffic counts or impacts
- 3. Budget & Schedule
- 4. Attachments:
 - a) Typical section
 - b) Concept layout
 - c) Commitment letter for matching funds
 - d) Support letters
