# Title VI Policy Statement

- It is the policy of the Atlanta Regional Commission that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, disability, or age, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination in any operation of the Atlanta Regional Commission as provided by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related statutes.



# DOT Objectives

- Ensure that the level and quality of transportation service is provided without regard to race, color, or national origin;
- Identify and address, as appropriate, disproportionately high and adverse human health and environmental effects, including social and economic effects of programs and activities on minority populations and low-income populations;
- Promote the full and fair participation of all affected populations in transportation decision making;
- Prevent the denial, reduction, or delay in benefits related to programs and activities that benefit minority populations or low-income populations;
- Ensure meaningful access to programs and activities by persons with limited English proficiency.

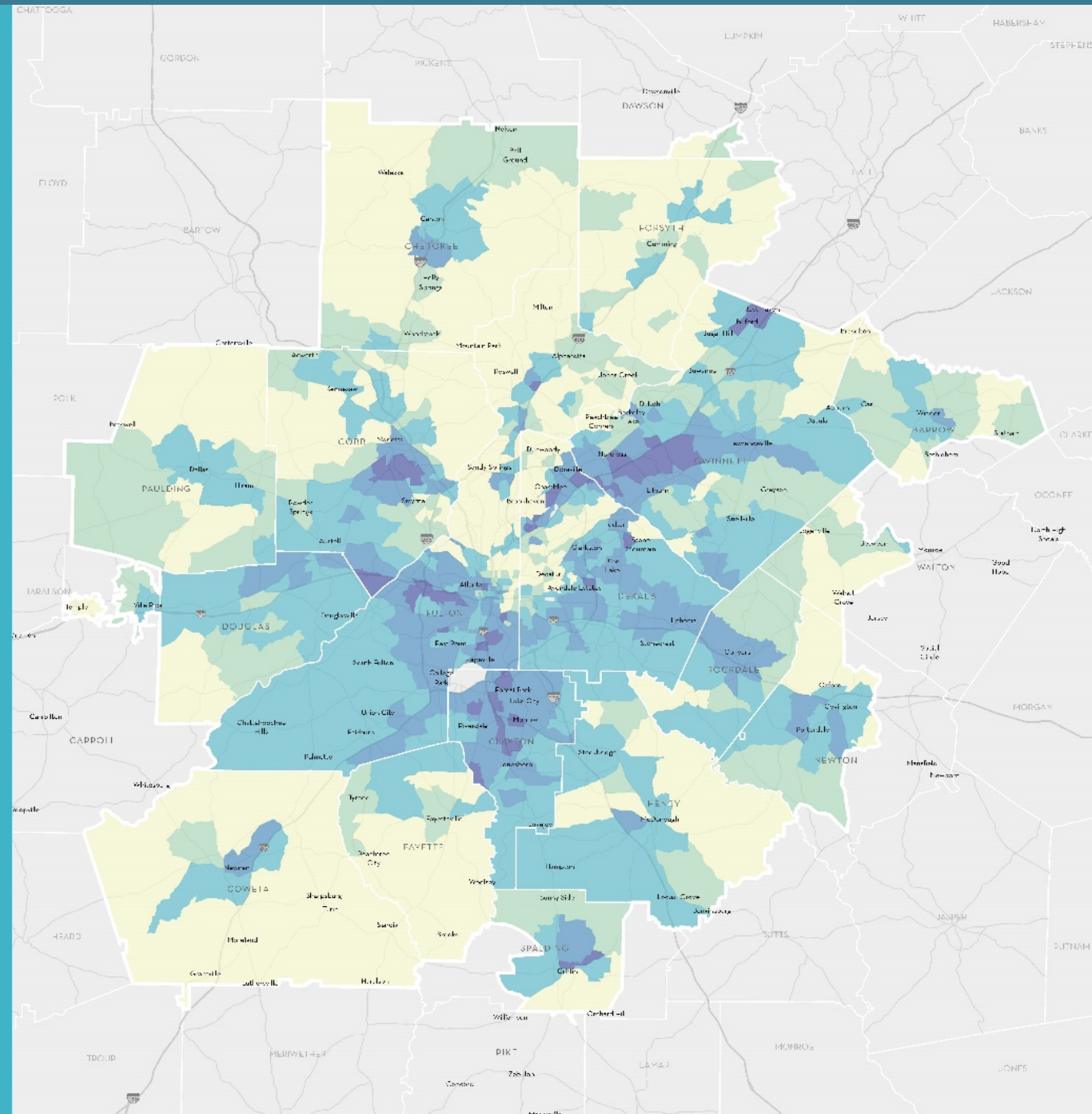
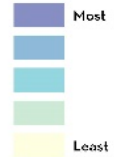
# 2019 Updates

- Added programmatic requirements for Workforce Investment Opportunity Act and Older Americans Act subgrantees
- Updated Title VI Complaints received within the last three years (NONE)

## Equity Analysis: Environmental Justice Model

The adjacent map reflects concentrations of racial minorities, ethnic minorities, and low-income populations at the census tract level across the region. The results guide regional transportation and land use planning investments. In particular, the ARC Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Project Evaluation Framework utilizes the results of this analysis to score and rank proposed projects.
