- Tested for east of use as both a host and participant, audio/visual quality, special features, etc.
- Decided to use Microsoft Teams

VIRTUAL ENGAGEMENT: KNOW YOUR AUDIENCE

 - Offered availability to walk through/test out program
 - Stated the day of the meeting, I would join meeting 30 minutes early to help troubleshoot



HOSTING VIRTUAL MEETING

- Script
 - Virtually, can't rely on reading body language and facial cues of your audience
 - Helps ensure clarity
 - Explain graphics before discussing implications
 - Helps audience keep pace
 - Accounts for different learning styles

Create script, include descriptions of graphics



VIRTUAL MEETINGS: CHALLENGES

- Oversight: Most steering committee members did not have built-in microphones
 - Could not participate verbally
- Solution: Committee provided input using Microsoft Teams "chat" feature
- Moving forward: Use a program with a dial-in option



LESSONS FOR SECOND MEETING

- Used GoTo Meeting
 - Dial-in option
- Everyone could participate verball
- More collaborative, conversationa



DEVELOPING A SURVEY

- Survey will be deployed as the first community engagement piece
- Surveys may reach a broader range of individuals than in-person meeting
- Consideration: not the most effective method to reach very low income, elderly – demographics often underrepresented in planning
 - Important to consider as many planning events become virtual

LESSONS LEARNED IN TRANSITION TO VIRTUAL

- Know your audience
 - Identify measures needed for full participation
 - i.e. sending "how to" instructions, assistance troubleshooting
- Dial-in option allows for broader participation
